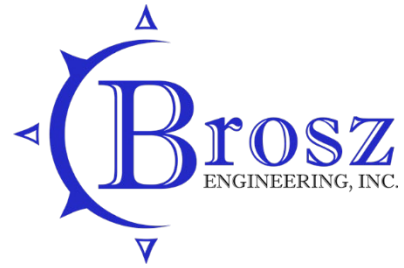


Position: Project Engineer/EIT – Land Development
Location: Sioux Falls, South Dakota



Qualifications

Candidate must possess a minimum of a bachelor's degree in civil engineering from an accredited university/college and/or at least five years of progressively responsible experience working on civil engineering activities relating to survey, design, drafting, and construction inspection. Preference will be given to EI candidates with 2-5 years of civil engineering project design and construction experience.

Primary Responsibilities

Primary responsibilities include performing as a staff engineer involved in the basic engineering activities for design and plan production of land development projects. The engineer candidate can be expected to be involved in and gain experience in design of residential, commercial, and institutional land developments and site plans. This work includes design and drafting of site grading, streets, drainage, storm sewer, sanitary sewer, water main, and street lighting. Engineer will learn to apply engineering standards, zoning requirements, specifications and relevant codes and statutes toward the development of basic design plans for internal review and learn basic plan production and drafting requirements to ensure all plans meet both internal and external requirements of the project.

Work Conditions and Schedule

General professional business office conditions with office hours of Monday-Friday 7AM to 5PM. Engineer may be required to visit projects in the field in all types of weather conditions. Meeting attendance or construction schedules may require some evening or weekend work. Some local and regional travel and occasional overnight stays may be required.

Reporting Relationships

The Project Engineer/EIT position works under the direction of the Department Head.

Salary and Benefits

Salary will be at a level commensurate with other Engineer IV positions in the company.
